Re: International Hapkido Federation Seminar and Promotional Testing

Please accept this invitation for an **International Hapkido Federation** seminar hosted through the **US Central Taekwondo Association** and **US Central Hapkido Association**. The seminar will be held at the USCTA main gymnasium, 10801 S. Sunnyslane, Oklahoma City, OK on October 7-8 and October 14-15. The US Central Hapkido Association is the only US organization affiliated with the International Hapkido Federation.

It has been five years since we had the honor of hosting a seminar taught by Grandmaster Joo Sik Ko, 9th Dan Black Belt, Chairman of Education and Demonstration Team Captain for the International Hapkido Federation. During his last visit, he taught almost 100 practitioners, and over 30 were certified black belt based on their current rank and skill level.

This is an excellent opportunity for you to learn pure Hapkido from a world class instructor. Grandmaster Ko is an excellent seminar conductor who travels internationally. You may have seen YouTube videos of him conducting seminars in Russia, Brazil, and many other countries. Grandmaster Ko will be travelling from South Korea especially for this occasion.

As you may know, Hapkido is the Korean martial art that focuses on self-defense and weapons and shares many traits with Taekwondo. Many schools teach Hapkido as part of their Taekwondo program, although not uniquely recognized as such. In this seminar you will learn basic and advanced techniques related to kicks, falls, hand-to-hand combat, joint locks, grappling, forms, weapons, and teaching techniques.

Along with greatly enhancing your existing skills, you will obtain the tools for reshaping your school's self-defense curriculum, thus enabling you to enhance student retention, and enhance the overall quality of your school to better serve your students and compete in the ever increasing competitive field of martial arts.

Each attendee will receive an official certificate of participation from the International Hapkido Federation.

If you wish to test for Hapkido black belt, there will be an optional Black Belt Testing for a fee after the seminar. To test, you must currently hold a Taekwondo Black Belt, attend at least 2 seminar days, and bring two passport size photos. The testing includes official certificates from the US Central Hapkido Association, the International Hapkido Federation and a wallet I.D. If you are interested, call to obtain testing registration information.

This seminar has limited availability. Don't miss this chance to learn from the finest so that you and your school can be armed with the most accurate information.

We have scheduled the seminars to accommodate your schedule. You may choose to register for any one or more of the four days: \$75 for 1 day, \$125 for 2 days, \$150 for 3-4 days.
